Towards the Fourth Centenary of the birth of Spinoza

Baruch Spinoza was born into the Jewish community of Amsterdam in 1632. Hence, the fourth centenary of his birth is approaching. Can eternity be degraded to the number of years? Probably not. We propose to celebrate an act that Spinoza himself would not have approved: the preservation of his memory and his work. In his world, proper names dissolve in the immensity of the whole, only the intensities and the ideas survive the bonfire of the years. He suffered the harassment of all churches and, with no less intensity, all the prejudices of his time. This is not to be overlooked. If we assume that his *Ethics*, a kind of secular Bible of humanity, is still called to illuminate our clumsy steps, we claim the need to return to his lessons of prudence and understanding.

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
